

Linchfield Primary School - Learning Overview – Term 3



<p style="text-align: center;">Art-</p> <p>We will be introduced to the idea that artists work in studios, outside, paint from life and are inspired by the land and cityscapes where they live. We will learn to use creative freedom to explore ways of working which involve different materials and media.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science –</p> <p>In Science, we will be learning about different Materials and their properties. We will compare and group materials based on their properties and understand how chemists create new materials.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE –</p> <p>In Dance, we will learn how to structure movements using dynamic moves, balance and control and understanding special. In Tag Rugby (3 weeks), we will develop our understanding of the attacking and defending principles of invasion games. We will also be learning Tennis (3 weeks) looking at using the forehand, backhand and keeping a rally going.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>In reading this term, the children will cover fiction, non-fiction and poetry. The children will read ‘The Adventures of Odysseus’ by Daniel Morden and Hugh Lupton. We will then explore and perform the poem ‘The Highway Man’ by Alfred Noyes. Afterwards, we will read a range of explanation texts and complete/answer comprehension questions.</p>	<p>Year 5</p> <p>Maple – Miss Cross</p> <p>Elder – Miss Seton</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>During this term, we will explore stories from other cultures and retell the cultural story ‘The Ride of Passage’.</p> <p>For our non-fiction writing, we will write an explanation text, explaining how the water cycle works.</p> <p>We will also create a narrative poem about the environment.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Music – Make You Feel my Love</p> <p>We will be looking at the pop ballad ‘Make You Feel My Love’ by Adele. During this unit of music, the children will listen and appraise similar music from the genre. They will learn to sing, play along, improvise, compose and perform to this song.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>This term, we will be adding to our knowledge and understanding of multiplication and division, by learning to multiply up to 4-digit numbers by up to 2-digit numbers, using formal written methods. We will then move on to division, using formal written methods to divide up to 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p>We will be learning about ‘Myself, My Relationships and My emotions’. In this topic, children will manage their emotions, learn about strategies to support their mental health and wellbeing and identify when and how to get support.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Spanish</p> <p>In Spanish this term, we will be learning about ‘My Home’. We will learn how to say sentences relating to where we live and how many rooms we have in our homes.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Computing-</p> <p>This term we will become Film Producers. We will learn how to capture video using a range of techniques, on a digital device. After creating a storyboard, we will shoot, reshoot and edit our video.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography-</p> <p>This term is focussed on the Water Cycle. We will begin by exploring the water on our planet, extending our learning by understanding and explaining the water cycle, why water is needed and how we use it. The difference in water availability and usage in different areas in the world will be assessed.</p>
