Coastal Explorers

Our focus this term will be:

Multiplication and Division

- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.
- Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by using objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support.

Fractions

- Recognise, find and name a half of an object, shape or quantity.
- Recognise, find and name a quarter of an object, shape or quantity.

Geometry – Position and Direction

 Describe position, direction and movement, including half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

- Continue to represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20 <u>Hit the Button - Quick fire maths practise for 6-11</u> year olds (topmarks.co.uk) Play number bonds to 10 or number bonds to 20.
- Practise grouping toys into twos, fives or tens and count them in twos, fives or tens.
- Use dice to make addition and subtraction calculations.
 E.g. 4+6 =? 6 4 =? Answer them as quickly as possible. Can you do it without counting on or back?
- Find 1 more or 1 less than a given number up to 100. Choose your challenge: <u>Chopper Squad More or Less Mental Maths Game 5 to 7 Year Olds</u> (topmarks.co.uk)



Reading records will be sent home each day. Your child can bring home 2 books at a time.

Book 1 – A Read Write Inc book that that matches the sounds taught in phonics sessions.

Book 2 – A picture book of their choice to share with adults at home. Children are not expected to read this by themselves.

Please read with your child every day and fill in the reading record at least 3 times a week.

We will listen to the children read as part of our phonics sessions.

Writing will be taught during our phonics lessons. Our vocabulary, grammar and punctuation focus will continue to be....

- Capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.
- Finger spaces in our writing and using the correct letter formation.
- Using and to join two ideas.
- Using a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and 'I'.

You could:

- Write a story based on the seaside.
- Describe a colourful seaside picture. This could be a postcard, a family photo or any another image you can find.

SCIENCE Our focus this term will be on plants.

COPIC

Go outside into your garden or a local park. You could even visit someone you know that has a garden with lots of plants.

Look for plants. Can you name them?

Can you predict what the plants will turn into when they are fully grown?

HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY

Our focus this term will be Geography. We will be learning about coastal exploration.

Create a seaside in a shoe box or create a picture of your favourite activity you like to do at the seaside.

ART/DT

Our focus this term will be on cookery and seaside snacks.

Can you help prepare a family meal? Perhaps you could pour your own cereal or wash and prepare some vegetables?

Can you follow a recipe to make one of your favourite treats?

Go for a walk and look at places of worship in our local area. How are they the same? How are they different?

PSHE - Healthy and Safer Lifestyles Our focus will be on personal safety and managing risk.

Do you know your name, address and phone number? If not, please learn them. Can you talk about what makes a place or activity safe for you?

Above are some suggested activities, you may wish to create some of your own. We see homework as enrichment, not punishment, so will set tasks on a termly basis to help enhance your child's education. Homework is not chased up' but we do celebrate homework in class.
