
Zoom Call with Jofi School in The Gambia

Earrings

If children have their ears pierced they are only allowed to wear one pair of plain studs to school.

A polite reminder that children are not permitted to wear earrings for PE lessons for health and safety reasons. Wearing earrings can result in both the tearing of the ear lobe and the post of the earring going into the neck. Children are not allowed to put tape over their earrings for PE lessons, so they need to be able to independently take their earrings out and replace them.

If you choose to get your child's ears pierced, then we suggest doing this at the start of the summer holidays so that they can keep them in for the recommended 4-6 weeks after piercing.

PE is a compulsory and important subject under the National Curriculum, and we want to ensure that all pupils can access all subjects safely.
