Fire Safety Workshop

Year 2 and Year 6 recently took part in a Fire Safety workshop. Lincolnshire fire safety team talked to the children about how to keep safe during a fire, who to call and how to prevent a fire. The children spotted all of the fire hazards in the home and what to do if one of them caught fire. The children were also reminded about the importance of smoke detectors and were encouraged to talk to their adults at home and check if they were working and discuss an evacuation plan. They then discussed flammable items and what to do if their clothing caught fire (STOP, DROP and ROLL). The workshop was extremely valuable and the children and adults learnt a lot!
