Year 6 SAT's Week

We would like to remind parents that **Year 6 SAT's week is Monday 9th May to Thursday 12th May**, and that holiday from school in this time will not be authorised. Should your child fall ill during SAT's week, we urge you to telephone the school office as soon as possible to seek further guidance.

We would advise plenty of early nights and a little gentle exercise at all times but particularly during this time. We will be opening school up from **8am** for Year 6 during SAT's week and inviting them to join us for a **free breakfast** - more details nearer the time. Coming into school earlier gives the children the opportunity to have a relaxed breakfast and a chat with their friends prior to sitting the SAT's and it means that they are in school in good time and not rushing around.

The children have worked really hard in preparation for the SAT's and we are super proud of all of the hard work and effort that they have put in. They have all made excellent progress. We know that tests can be stressful but the Year 6 Team have done an excellent job of ensuring that the children are well prepared and familiar with the style of tests that they will be sitting. The children have a wide variety of skills and talents across the curriculum and they are celebrated in a variety of ways but the SAT's are a great opportunity to showcase everything that they have learnt in English and Maths at Primary School. Also, having an assessment week is good experience prior to moving on to secondary school.
