Year 5 First Aid

Year 5 gained experience in First Aid, in a very beneficial and interesting workshop. They started by focussing on applying bandages and slings, before moving on to first aid treatments for more severe incidents, such as anaphylaxis and CPR. The children were shown how Epipen and Jext Pens work in the event of anaphylaxis, and even got to experience a training version, which contained no needles but simulated what would happen in a real-life scenario. Finally, the children learnt how to administer life-saving CPR, including chest compressions and mouth to mouth. They practiced on a mannequin, whose chest would raise when successful breaths were given. The children are now ready to save lives!



World War II

This week, Year 6 were fortunate to be visited by a Blitz survivor (Mrs Donnelly's mum Pearl). During this visit, the children listened respectfully to the experiences of her time in London during World War 2 experiencing the Blitz. The children then had the opportunity to ask questions, which they did in a mature and thoughtful way. This opportunity embedded the children's knowledge of this historical period.
