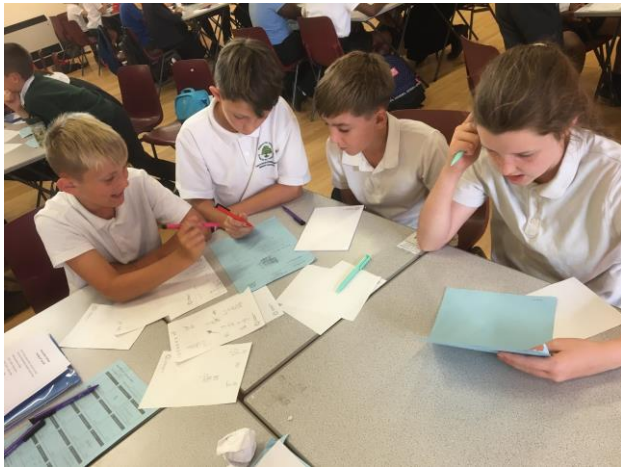
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Primary Mathematics Challenge

The team from Linchfield: Ahren, Joey, Jessica and Ethan, all displayed great teamwork and performed brilliantly, solving problems that required both logical and lateral thinking to reach a solution. Graffiti

We have been informed by Deeping St James Parish Council that there has been a number of incidents involving graffiti at the skatepark on Linchfield Road recently. Most of it has been done with marker pens rather than spray paint.

The most recent was one evening last week and on this occasion the CCTV shows that among those using the skate park there were some in primary school uniform.

Deeping St James Parish Council are communicating with the local neighbourhood policing team and all of the schools in the local area to try and put a stop to this.

We have spoken to all of our children in school about how this behaviour is not acceptable as it costs a lot of money in products and time to clean off and could damage the surface of the park reducing its lifespan. Your child can try on and you can buy on the day. It is really helpful if you can measure your child prior to your appointment - chest/bust, waist and inside leg.

We will not be able to offer counter sales at this time.

We will continue with sizing appointments over the whole summer period.
